Characteristics of Glen Mor (RBC16F6)

- Early season
- Good productivity
- Good flavour
- Resistant to *Phytophthora* root rot
- Upright, spine-free canes

Cropping Season

In Scotland RBC16F6 starts cropping 7-10 days before Glen Ample.

Fruit Quality

Large fruit, with size maintained well during season, good flavour and shelf life. Fruit Yield
Good yield potential, producing higher yields than Glen Ample and Cascade Delight in soil and substrate trials.

Plant Characteristics

Upright, spine-free canes with short internodes. RBC16F6 has good potential for long cane production, with a lower chill requirement than standard florican varieties.

Disease Resistance

RBC16F6 has the molecular marker for *Phytophthora* resistance and displays good resistance to root rot in infested soils. It is also resistant to the main biotypes of the large raspberry aphid (*Amphorophora idaei*).

Plant Supply

RBC16F6 (Glen Mor) is protected under Community (EU) Plant Variety Rights Application No. 2019/2569. The propagation and sale of plants, or parts of plants, of RBC16F6 without a licence is prohibited.
