Season: Slightly earlier than Heritage
Main characteristic/s: Primocane; very large fruit with excellent aromatic flavour.
Breeder: Marionnet SAS, France

Characteristics of Paris

- Very large fruit size
- Excellent aromatic flavour
- Good firmness & shelf life
- Tolerant to the main raspberry pests & diseases

Cropping Season

The picking season is slightly earlier than Heritage.

Fruit Quality

The fruit are very large averaging between 5g to 6.5g with uniform, short conical slightly rounded berry shape. The berries are a lighter colour than Polka with a very good aromatic flavour, good firmness and shelf life. Fruit Yield Paris produces good fruit yields

Plant Characteristics

The canes are self-supportive, vigorous and very robust with an upright habit. Fruiting occurs mainly on the top half of the cane, with very few laterals on the lower half of the cane as a primocane. Fruit display is good allowing an easy harvest.

Disease Resistance

Paris is very tolerant to the main raspberry pests and diseases.

Plant Supply

Paris is protected under Community (EU) Plant Variety Rights Grant No. EU 43223; Canada PBR Grant No. 5764; Mexico PVR Grant No. 2097; Morocco PBR Application No. 523/14; Serbia PBR Grant No. 20-04-01679/3/2017-11. The propagation and sale of plants, or parts of plants, of Paris without a licence is prohibited. Only Propagation Licence holders can propagate and receive propagation grade material (and not Sales or Growing-on Transformation Licence holders).
